



## ***IMPORTANT RULES FOR HOLIDAY GUESTS AND GROUPS***

### **Houses:**

- The number of persons per house are determined by the number of beds in the house.
- Bring a lock if you want to lock your belongings in the cabinet. You receive a key to the house. (Groups will not have access to cabinets, they live out of their suitcases. Provision will be made for coaches and teachers.)
- The house must be tidy at 10:00 on the day of departure.
- No double beds are available.
- Bring own lamps or headlamps in case of a power failure.
- All buildings are non smoking areas - including all rooms and entrances. NO EXCEPTIONS! This also applies to any Hubbly Bubbly.
- Make sure you know how the meter (hot water) in the house works. Report if there are less than 50 units of power on the meter.
- Work carefully with the DSTV remote, blinds and the toilet mechanism.
- The use of sticky tape or cello tape on walls is permitted.
- No pets are allowed.

### **Safety:**

- Emergency numbers are on the notice board at the office or on your fridge.
- Fires may only be made in braai drums.
- Avoid storing flammable substances or the use of other dangerous acts like fireworks, fire crackers and whips.
- Close doors and "open" windows when you leave home.
- Do not leave possessions in front of "open windows".
- Use a multi-plug (SABS) with separate switches if necessary.

### **Furniture/equipment:**

- No furniture (chairs not included), mattresses and equipment may be removed from homes without permission.
- Mattresses may not be removed from the room to the living room or elsewhere .
- No heaters, elements and electric blankets are allowed.
- Look well after the property and report problems immediately - do not try to fix problems yourself. Report if a bulb fuses.
- Feet are not allowed on furniture.
- Only use washing powder for automatic washing machines. Use the washing lines outside – not the window rails.

- Keep the temperature of refrigerators as set on 3 or 4, and do not remove, or overloaded racks too heavily.

#### **Music:**

- No loud music that disturb others will be tolerated. Maintain a peaceful atmosphere after 23:00.
- Report misconduct immediately.
- It is not permitted to listen to music out of car while you braai outside.

#### **Bathrooms:**

- Open windows after shower to prevent dampness on the ceiling and walls.
- Use water sparingly, for the benefit of all.
- Leave the bathroom just as neat as you would like to find it.

#### **Cleaning:**

- Houses, dishes and laundry are your responsibility (self-care). Cleaning services can be hired. Contact the person on duty.
- Toilet paper and dishwash are provided once on arrival.
- There is a broom and mop, etc. available in the house.
- Take all reasonable measures to avoid blockages and obstructions in pipes.
- Keep homes neatly outside. Also clean up at the outside after a braai.

#### **Vehicles:**

- Drive responsible at all times. The speed limit in the complex is 25 km/h.
- No person will be allowed to overnight in a car in the parking area.
- We cannot accept responsibility for any damage or theft.
- Use parking bays at the homes – do not park in the road or on lawns.
- If you want to wash your car, use a bucket for it.

#### **Recreation:**

- No ball games, roller skates or bikes are allowed in the houses.
- Rules are provided at the recreation room.
- Primary school children must be accompanied by their parents or an adult to the recreation room.

#### **General:**

- Facilities are used at your own risk. We cannot accept responsibility for any damage, lost property or injuries.
- Leave bedding in the house when you leave, and leave the key (s) into the postbox at Lions Head 6.
- The Rugby Academy staff or delegate (s), may search any vehicle or object on the premises or in the house for dangerous or unwanted items.
- Please leave the house as tidy as you got it on arrival.
